



Paper Submission Guidelines for Authors

Authors who wish to submit a paper to ISPST 2026 should use [the official conference website](https://ispst.aut.ac.ir/en). The submission process usually includes creating a user account, signing in to the dashboard, completing the author profile, preparing the manuscript according to the paper formatting guidelines, entering paper information, uploading the manuscript file, and confirming the final submission.

Please read this guide carefully before starting the submission. Completing the required information in advance will reduce errors and save time.

Step-by-Step Paper Submission

Step 1 - Visit the official website

Go to <https://ispst.aut.ac.ir/en>. Make sure you are using the official ISPST 2026 website before entering any personal information.

Step 2 - Create a user account

Click **Sign Up**. Complete the registration form with your personal details, email address, password, affiliation, and other required fields. After registration, check your email for any activation or confirmation message if the system sends one.

Step 3 - Sign in to your account





Click **Sign in** and enter your registered email address and password. After login, you will be redirected to the user dashboard or account panel.

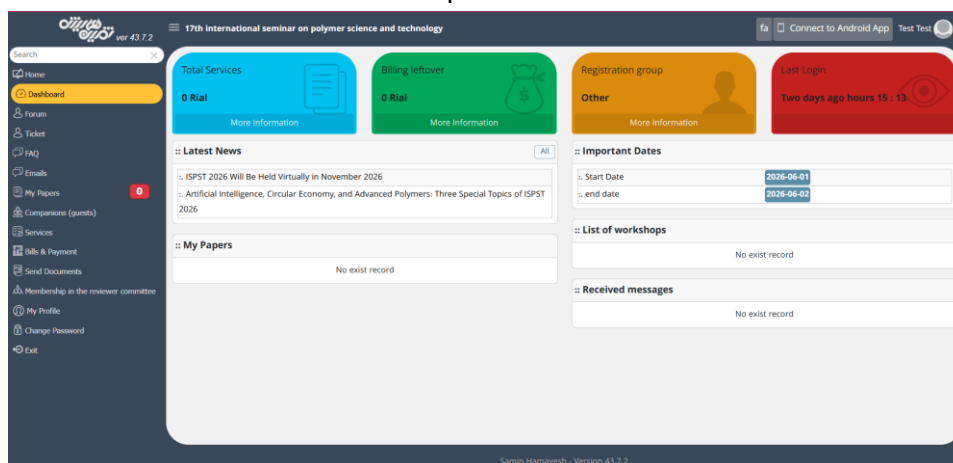


Figure 2: Dashboard

Step 4 - Complete your profile

Before submitting a paper, review your profile information. Make sure your full name, affiliation, academic position, contact information, and country are correct. Incomplete profile information may cause problems during submission or certificate issuance.

Step 5 - Download and follow the paper formatting guideline

From the conference website, open the [Paper Formatting Guidelines](#) section. Prepare your manuscript according to the required format, page layout, font style, file type, and other instructions announced by the conference.

Step 6 - Start a new paper submission

In the user dashboard, select the **My Papers** section, then click **Submit New Paper**



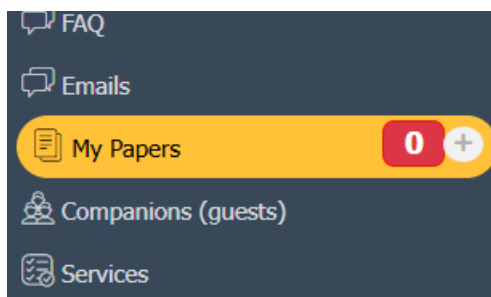


Figure 2: Choose My Papers

Step 7 - Enter paper information

Fill in the paper title, abstract, keywords, topic/track, and any other required scientific information. Check spelling, capitalization, and author names carefully before continuing.

Step 8 - Add authors

Enter all authors in the correct order. For each author, add the full name, affiliation, email address, and country if required. Select the corresponding author and presenting author according to the system options.

Step 9 - Upload the manuscript file

Upload the prepared manuscript file in the required format. Before uploading, make sure the file opens correctly, has the correct file name, and does not include unwanted comments, tracked changes, or hidden editing marks.

Step 10 - Save the tracking information

Before final submission, carefully review all entered information, including the paper title, abstract, keywords, authors' names, affiliations, and the uploaded manuscript file. After making sure that all information is correct, click the final submit/confirm button. Do not close the browser until the system confirms that the submission has been completed.

After submission, the system show a paper code. Save this information for future correspondence and status tracking

Manuscript Preparation Checklist

Before submitting the manuscript,



check the following items:



- The manuscript is written in clear academic English.
- The title, author names, affiliations, abstract, and keywords are complete.
- The manuscript follows the official [paper formatting template](#).
- Figures and tables are clear and readable.
- References are complete and formatted consistently.
- The uploaded file is the final version intended for review.
